

CONTRACT

The person signing below (client) agrees to this contract with Transitional Food & Shelter, Inc.

Client must leave if he/she does not abide by all program rules and cooperate with all caseworkers assigned to him/her by other agencies, or if Transitional Food & Shelter, Inc. can no longer provide the shelter space or needs it for another client.

There will be no smoking or drinking of alcoholic beverages in the shelter unit provided, and no use of candles or open fires. Clients must not have parties, use of illegal drugs or allow the use of drugs by others, or associate with drug dealers. Clients must be respectful to neighbors.

The unit provided and the household goods must be kept clean by the client, and left clean for the next client, including washing the sheets and towels.

The client must leave when requested to do so by a caseworker or someone from Transitional Food & Shelter, Inc. and must remove all of his/her belongings when leaving. Failure to remove all of his/her belongings constitutes abandonment of any belongings left behind.

Any caseworker or representative of Transitional Food & Shelter, Inc. or of the owner of the property may enter the shelter unit provided at any time, whether the client is present or not.

Client will not make holes in the walls, paint, draw or write on any part of the dwelling unit, nor change the locks or damage the unit, furniture or household goods in any way. Client agrees to pay for repairs for any damage done by him/her or members of his/her household.

Client will pay \$_____ per month to Transitional Food & Shelter, Inc.

On leaving, client will not take any of the furniture or household goods which belong to the unit.

Client understands that he/she is subject to the Transitional Housing Misconduct Act of the California Health & Safety Code #50580 et seq. paper relating to this attached.
